OUTPace AMBASSADOR PROGRAM

Become an OUTPace Program Ambassador!

Students who formally join and actively participate in the OUTPace drop-in sessions will get a chance to apply to our OUTPace Ambassador Program and possibly become a student ambassador.

What is the OUTPace Ambassador Program?

The OUTPace Ambassador Program is an initiative focused on increasing the number of LGBTQ+ youth in leadership roles in schools, extra curricular activities and in their own communities. It is also an opportunity for you to be at the forefront with SRPS, as we work towards transforming students' lives through our core principles of Courage, Effort and Respect.

What does an OUTPace Ambassador do?

OUTPace program ambassadors will contribute to the creation of safe and welcoming places that will have a positive impact in increasing respect, acceptance and understanding of other LGTBQ+ students and their experiences. We estimate the time commitment to be about 4 hours per month for a full season. Duties performed by an OUTPace Ambassador are:

- Represent SRPS at local events, including LGBTQ+ focused events such as the Philly Pride Run 5K, and others.
- With the support of the program's staff, OUTPace ambassadors will also lead monthly
 activities and initiatives, including helping to facilitate the monthly drop-in program and
 recruiting.
- Ambassadors will be the face and voice of OUTPace at in-person events and via social media communication.

How many Ambassadors will there be?

There will be (2) OUTPace Student Ambassadors picked for this program.

Who can become an Ambassador?

Interested youth between the ages of 15-23 can submit an application for consideration. Potential ambassadors should be active participants of SRPS and OUTPace drop-in sessions. Applicants should be committed to and enthusiastic about centering LGBTQ+ youth. Applicants should be caring, reliable, team oriented, able to work with diverse groups, social media savvy, flexible and eager to learn leadership & advocacy skills.

What are the benefits?

Through their active contribution and completion of the program's tasks, set forth by the program's staff, student ambassadors will have the opportunity to develop and enhance their leadership and communication skills while making a difference in their communities and having a positive impact on those around them. Student Ambassadors will also get the opportunity to work alongside other students and community leaders to expand their network and learn how to

take action and advocate for LGBTQ+ youth. In addition, for the completion of their duties within the program, time and dedication, Ambassadors will receive a \$250 stipend. The stipend will be distributed in two increments, with the first payment being made halfway through the season and the second and final payment made at the end of the season.
